

Ann Rhodes (Alexander Technique) - Dr. Ann Rhodes is a professor of vocal music who has been actively involved in the study and application of the Alexander Technique for nearly thirty years. She started formal study of the Alexander Technique in Pittsburgh and Philadelphia, and continued training in Leeds, England.

Dr. Rhodes received her certification in 2006 from the Alexander Technique of Cincinnati, an American Society of Alexander Teachers training program. Over the past fifteen years, Dr. Rhodes has specialized in working with vocalists and instrumentalists at colleges and universities in Pennsylvania, Ohio, Virginia, and Kentucky. She has been an active participant in workshops and conferences in Ohio, Virginia, California, London, England and Galway, Ireland. Dr. Rhodes is currently an Associate Professor of Music at Berea College in Berea, Kentucky where she teaches voice, music history, vocal pedagogy and Alexander Technique for Musicians. She also maintains a private voice and Alexander Technique studio in Berea, KY.
