

Tracey Bonner (Director of Musical Theatre, 16 Bar) - Tracey Bonner (Laguna Beach, CA) has worked across the country as a performer and choreographer and currently serves on the dance faculty at Miracosta College in Oceanside, University of California, Irvine, teaching jazz, tap, movement for the actor, and choreographer for Insight jazz ensemble. Tracey is also a theatre faculty member at Azusa Pacific University, where she teaches tap, jazz, actor movement and serves as departmental choreographer. As a performer, Tracey toured nationally with *West Side Story*, *A Chorus Line*, *Show Boat*, and *Fosse* and while in New York City she performed with companies of *Fosse*, *A Chorus Line*, and *Radio City Spectacular*. Regionally, she has performed in numerous shows from *Sweet Charity* to *Pippin*. As a Choreographer, Tracey has multiple credits including the Off-Broadway and World Premieres, with United States Organization (USO) Iraqi Brigade shows of 2002-2004, Choreography for the Edinburgh Fringe Festival in 2001, *Radio City Rockettes*, and has over 40 musicals and 10 dance concerts to her credit.

Tracey has previously served on faculty at Wagner College in Staten Island, New York, American Musical and Dramatic Academy (AMDA), New York, New York, at New York's Theater and Dance Alliance, and recently led a musical theatre workshop at the University of Sonora in Hermosillo, Sonora, Mexico. Tracey received her BFA from Shenandoah Conservatory of Shenandoah University, her MFA from University of California, Irvine and is a member of SSDC and AEA professional artistic unions. Tracey is the Director for SummerFest's regional premiere of the musical, *Rent*, this July in the UK Arboretum!
